Em particular na industria editorial

- Estima-se que as livrarias nos USA e Europa irão diminuir em 50% o numero de livros impressos em 3 anos
- O faturamento de livros digitais cresceu em 21% entre 2014/2015
- O mercado de livros eletronicos já é superior a 20% das vendas nos USA
- No Brasil apenas 2% do faturamento com livros vem de e-books
